Notes to the Financial Statements For the Year ended 28 February 2010

1.STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW) and the Charitable Fundraising Act and related Regulations.

The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

2. CLOTHING STOCK ON HAND

This value has been estimated based on purchase and sales amounts for the year with an average mark up of \$1 to \$2 per item. Presentation of results have been changed from the previous year

3. ASSETS

All assets are capitalised and recorded in an asset register.

As items are used, lost or destroyed the relevant amount is charged against revenue.

All items of a minor nature below the cost of \$300 are written off in the year incurred 4. **LEASEHOLD IMPROVEMENTS**

These improvements were carried out in 2005 and consisted of improvements to the toilets and bathrooms in the clubhouse.

They were funded in part by a government grant

The committee estimates the improvements to have an effective life of 40 years.

5 **DEPRECIATION**

From the 2008 Financial Year onwards Assets are depreciated as follows:

- Leasehold Improvements are depreciated on a straight line basis over 40 years.
- Motor Vehicles are depreciated using the diminishing value method at 18.5% per year.
- Plant & Equipment are depreciated using the diminishing value method at 15% per year.

Prior to the 2008 Financial Year assets were depreciated as follows:

- Leasehold Improvements were not depreciated
- Plant & Equipment and Motor Vehicles were depreciated on a Straight Line basis over 5 to 15 Years.
