Boat Captain's Report

In the 2017/2018 season the boat section showed a strong representation of competitors in almost all the divisions. This season we saw crews hit the water for both training & competition as well as represented the Club in the following divisions; Reserve Male x 3, Reserve Female, Under 23 Male, under 23 female, open men's and vets male.

Port Kembla crews travelled along the New South Wales coast competing representing our Club in the local South Coast Boat Series, Illawarra Branch Championship, NSW Surf Life Saving Championship and Australian Surf Boat Rowers League.

After making regular appearances in final's across all the divisions it was the Illawarra Branch Carnival where we received a Bronze medal in the Reserve Male and Under 23 Male. However, the seniors of the Club had the last laugh with a strong performance picking up a Silver medal. The Illawarra Branch team also received a bronze medal at the best of the best carnival when a reserve crew participated.

This season provided the crews with more challenging surf conditions at both ASRL and State. That being said all the crews were able to handle the conditions fairly well. Unfortunately, no Port Kembla Crews made the trip to Perth for the Australian Surf Life Saving Championship this season.

Additionally, our surfboat section celebrated **Gary 'Herb' Staple's 50th year in competition** with style by hosting a comedy night at the surf club. The event attracted over 130 people and was a great success.

The club has purchase a second hand boat to ensure enough boats are available for training and competition. Thus we now have three operational surf boats.

Education Report

This season our Education Team, consisting of Jamie Rogan and Ray Simpson, restricted our focus to keeping members proficient and to Education for the Surf Rescue Certificate, Bronze Medallion, IRB crew and drivers and to Beach Management. For all of these courses were delivered. There were 2 Bronze Medallion course run, one for younger members and a second for the twenty plus age group. As a result of our Education program we have now added to our ranks:

- 14 new SRC members
- 15 Bronze Medallion members
- 12 additional IRB crew members
- 8 new Silver Medal IRB drivers
- 2 more members qualified in Silver Medal Beach Management.



An aim of our team had been to add to our training team, with 2 interested members, but unfortunately this did not happen as the training course clashed with Branch Championships in which they were competing. We will try again for next season but it should be noted that without additional training staff it is difficult to run more than the basic courses.



Maintaining member proficiency is a task requiring a great deal of time and effort. I would like to thank our Patrol Captains as delegates, for their efforts to ensure their patrol meets requirements and referring those not able to attend patrol proficiencies came to our Bulk proficiency sessions. It is also timely to remind members that proficiencies need to be done annually for Bronze, IRB and Advanced resuscitation awards to maintain your qualification.



I would also like to thank those who gave a little of their time and effort to assist with training this year, whether it be to provide Water Safety or expertise, thank you for making our role easier.

Our team look forward to working with our members again in the 2018/9 season.

I would also like to thank Jamie Rogan for running all of the IRB courses and making everyone feel highly competent in the vehicle, whilst also ensuring everyone had an incredible time.

Competitions: This year, the club had a number of juniors participating in competitive events and carnivals. A congratulation is in due for Alex Pozzer who competed, wonderfully represented the club, and won a number of activities. Alex won first place in the Port Kembla 'King of the Hill' race, first place in the Port Kembla 'John Birch' handicap pool swim, 2nd place in the Under 17 ski race at the Branch Championships, made the semi-finals for the Under 17 ski race, and competed in a range of other surf club carnivals.

The 2017/2018, season saw the first year that the Under 23 boat crew competed in surf boat carnivals. The team consisted of Kiandra Kaiser, Avalon Rose, Renee Crowe and Abbey Dawson, coached and swept collectively by David Edwards David Erskine and Nathan Boscaro. Although not incredibly successful ;), we all had a wonderful time creating our own little friendship circle and being a part of a supportive group of people. We made the finals in one carnival and went to compete at state in Swansea. Thank you to everyone who made it possible for all of us and supported us all season. 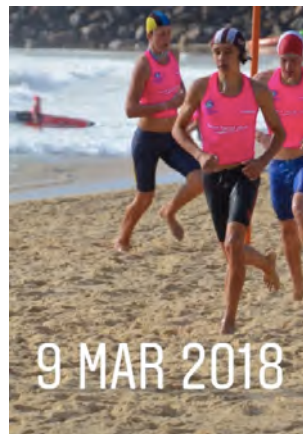

Port Kembla Nippers Surf Life Saving President's Report

Another wonderful season with few cancellations, unfortunately surf conditions were affected at times limiting both the number of water activities and point scores. All Nippers with the help of our wonderful volunteers developed new skills and were rewarded with their respective certificates. The focus for our club remains training our Nippers in open water surf safety with most weekends dedicated to skill development and training.

I would like to thank everyone who approached me during the season offering words of encouragement and feedback, it was truly appreciated.

Season Highlights

- 186 Nippers registered for the season (18% increase 2016/17 157) with only 2 transfers to other clubs and many coming from suburbs outside our area
- No medical injuries recorded
- All Nippers were able to fulfill their requirements for their age appropriate certificates which were issued by Surf Life Saving Academy
- 2 days were cancelled due to poor weather conditions towards the end of the season
- Surf activities were effected by poor conditions limiting us to conduct only a few skill sets and opportunities for point score
- Resuscitation and rescue techniques practiced in the Port Kembla pool
- U8 and above all practiced swims and boards in the surf
- New Committee member uniforms introduced to enable identification on the beach and functions. We have received extremely positive feedback
- Ross Schuback achieving 10 years with the club and retiring at the AGM
- Robert Donsante achieving 10 years with the club and retiring at the AGM
- An enjoyable night for our end of year presentation and AGM held at the Portuguese club Kemblawarra followed by a disco

1 Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This financial statement is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporations Act 2009 No.7 and the Charitable Fundraising Act & Legislation. The committee has determined that the club is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the following Australian Accounting Standards:

- AASB 1031 Materiality
- AASB110 Events after the Balancing date

No Australian Accounting Standards, Australian Accounting Interpretations Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been intentionally applied.

The statements are prepared on a cash basis. They are based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following material accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

Fixed Assets

Improvements made to the clubhouse, equipment and the building costs are carried at cost less accumulated depreciation. The depreciable amount of all fixed assets is depreciated over their useful life to the club commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use. Any asset costing less than \$1,000 is depreciated at 100% over a 12 month period.

Depreciation expense has been allocated accordingly between seniors and juniors. A summary is in the depreciation schedule attached to the management letter provided by the auditor.

Contributions - Government Grants and Donations

A non-reciprocal contribution or grant is recognised when the entity obtains control of the contribution or grant and it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the entity, and the amount of the contribution or grant can be measured reliably.

If conditions attached to the contribution or grant that must be satisfied before the entity is eligible to receive the contribution, recognition of contribution or income is deferred until those conditions are met.

A non-reciprocal donation is recognised when the right to receive a donation has been established.

When the entity receives grants but is obliged to give directly approximately equal value to the contributor, recognition of grant income will be deferred until the delivery of service. SLS NSW activities are supported by grants received from the State and Federal governments as well as private organisations. Grants received on the condition that specified services are delivered, or conditions are fulfilled, are considered reciprocal. Such grants are initially recognised as a liability and revenue recognised as services are performed or conditions fulfilled.
